Ninety-nine Years of Colt Fire Arms Manufacture

MONG the inspirational achievements of the nineteenth century, none stands out more clearly in its actual worth to human progress than that of Samuel Colt, who as a boy, in 1830, originated and made practical the idea of six pistols in one — the Colt Revolver. Sea-

born, for young Colt whittled out his first rough model while on a sailing ship Calcutta bound, romance and adventure have followed in its wake. But more than all, the Colt has stood throughout the years an emblem of protected right — an advocate of Law and Order.

The first Colt revolvers were made at Paterson, N. J., in 1836 by the Patent

Arms Company and, two years later, the so-called "Texas Pistol" was put on the market. From that time until the present day Colts have rendered valiant service in every American military engagement beginning with the Seminole uprising and throughout the World War, where Colts proved to be a deciding factor in the steady march of the A.E.F. toward the Armistice.



At the outbreak of the Mexican War in 1847, Colonel Colt received his first U.S. Government contract. From then until now "In consequence of marked superiority to any other known pistol," Colt Revolvers and Automatic Pistols have been the official side-arms of the Army, Navy and Marine Corps of the United States.

However, it has been during times of peace that Colts have meant most to the progress of America. Colts in the hands of intrepid and determined pioneers



policed the far western plains and mountains when the Mississippi river was virtually the Western frontier of our nation. Colts brought law and order to a vast empire which had been overrun with renegades, rogues and treacherous savages, and helped to make famous such inspiring names as Kit Carson, Fremont, Buffalo Bill, Pawnee Bill,

Wild Bill Hickok, Pat Garrett, Custer and a hundred other "dead shots" with the Colt — Sheridan, Phil Kearney, Scott, Dodge, Casement and Frederick Lee, all plainsmen who added luster to their names in later military engagements. Thus, Colts made possible the following of peaceful pursuits; the development of mining, cattle raising, agriculture and transportation.

Colts have for many years been the official Fire Arms approved for use by leading Police Departments, more than four hundred of the principal cities of the United States having adopted Colt Police Revolvers as their standard. This is true also of State Troopers, Express Messengers, Agents and Guards; Railway Detectives and Watchmen. Colt Fire Arms are also the accepted side-arms of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police and are regularly supplied for police and military use in Cuba, Guatemala, Honduras, Brazil, Argentina, Chile, Philippine Islands, Hawaii and by numerous other governments.

In the year 1848, Colonel Colt returned to his boyhood home, Hartford, Connecticut, where he established the Colt's Patent Fire Arms Manufacturing Company. There, on a 250-acre tract along the picturesque Connecticut River,



the mammoth Colt plant of today had its beginning. There it has grown from one small but well equipped factory to a tremendous organization, with buildings containing nearly a million square feet of floor space and a reputation for exacting craftsmanship second to none in all the world.

The Colt Company has always manufactured one grade only of Fire Arms and that of the highest possible quality in design, material and workmanship. Exactly the same quality of manufacture that is furnished to the United States Government for Marine, Navy and Army Service, to police departments and protective agencies the world over is furnished to every user of Colt Revolvers and Automatic Pistols. This is because every Arm turned out by the Colt organization is made on the same machines, by the same workmen, of the same material and must pass the same forms of inspection and test.

Colt Fire Arms are designed by men schooled in the arts and traditions of building firearms for a century, and many of the craftsmen doing and inspecting the particular work of Colt manufacture and assembly have been in the Colt organization for fifty years or more.

How Colt Fire Arms are Made

Every bar of steel used in Colt Fire Arms manufacture is compounded and rolled at the Steel Mills in accord with Colt specifications. Materials are not only carefully selected but are subjected to the most scientific analyses and tests by trained engineers and heat treated by expert metal hardeners. Parts are micrometer gauged for absolute accuracy, finishing operations carefully checked and assembly of Arms accomplished by expert workmen. Finally each Arm is adjusted, proof tested, and targeted by experienced marksmen to determine accuracy and exactness of operation, before it is put through the final inspection and is entitled to have stamped upon it the little triangular "Verified Proof" mark.

A brief description of some of the hundreds of operations necessary to produce a Colt Revolver or Automatic Pistol will suffice to show what infinite care and



skill is given to every step in their manufacture. From a forge a workman draws a bar of glowing steel. Under a thudding drop forging hammer it goes. The die descends with a force of several tons and the frame of a revolver or automatic pistol is roughly shaped. Blow after blow it receives, each fixing more firmly the fibres of the steel.

Deftly the metal is turned over and over as the descending die beats the tough steel into an unbreakable mass. Similarly, but of different steels, each selected for its peculiar properties of toughness or hardness, are forged the hammer, trigger, crane and other parts, no castings being used in any Colt Fire Arm.

In another department a skilled mechanic operates a machine which cuts the blanks from which revolver cylinders are made. This same automatic machine, which operates with uncanny dexterity, trues up the outer surface of the blank and bores the center hole; the chambers are then machine-reamed, grooved and counter-bored for ratchet and coupling and then the final operation of hand reaming is performed.




To follow the progress of a Revolver barrel through its many delicate operations from one skilled workman to another is to repeat the experience of the cylinder. In rifling the barrel, a feature of vast importance, Colt's acknowledge no equal. By an ingenious method the rifling of the barrel is spiraled in a direction opposite to the thread that fastens it to the frame so that a bullet passing through the barrel tends to keep the barrel tight in the frame.

Colt Quality Since 1836

Something of the infinite care given to every piece may be gleaned from the fact that in proving a single part of a Colt Automatic Pistol, 35 different gauges are used. The final finishing and gauging of frame and barrel as well

as hammer, trigger, sear and safety device, after forging and machining, is skilled hand work. Anyone observing the care and craftsmanship bestowed by the skilled artisans who do the work of fitting, assembling and adjusting these parts might well imagine them engaged on fine watch movements so painstaking is their task.



The mechanisms of the Colt Positive Lock and the Colt Automatic Grip Safety, which are exclusive features in these modern Arms are adjusted by the most competent and trustworthy workmen and must undergo a series of tests and provings that can leave no possibility of error in their action. It should be reassuring to possessors of Colt Arms that in its report on Colt Revolvers the Ordnance Board of the U. S. War Department states: "There is a positive safety device interposed under the hammer on rebound."

The durable and much admired finish which distinguishes Colt Fire Arms is accomplished by the most modern and thorough methods. The parts are first



polished by especially shaped wheels of many sizes and forms made to fit the various machined surfaces—flat, circular and other contours—and to apply the different grades of abrasives which are alternated to produce the mirror-like Colt finish. In this department is an intricate blower system which frees the work of excess abrasives and at the same time rids the air of all

particles, maintaining healthful working conditions.

Parts to be Blued go to a special department for that purpose, where the color

is changed by a scientifically controlled heat process, to that permanent and handsome "Blued Finish" with which every Sportsman and Fire Arms enthusiast is familiar. Other parts go from the polishing to the Metallurgical Department, packed in special containers, smothered in a special mixture and placed in the casehardening ovens where the beautifully mottled finish is imparted.



Nickel, Silver or Gold plating is applied in the Electro-Plating Department, where the parts are first electrically cleansed of all foreign surface matter, then to the electro-plating vats where a very heavy smooth plate is applied.

The finishes given to Colt Revolvers and Automatic Pistols result from years of experiment and experience to produce the best possible plating and blueing methods. The character of service demanded of Fire Arms, calls not alone for unusual skill in application of finishes but the best methods and equipment to insure maximum permanence of finish.

Silver and gold mountings, inlays, engravings and etching of special designs that delight fastidious sportsmen are done in a separate department by skilled artisans, whose work recalls the celebrated armorers of old. (See page 37.) Fitting of the stocks (ordinarily of finely checked walnut) is all that remains to make the Arm complete.

On the Colt firing range the expert marksmen assigned to the target tests

have no difficulty in making wonderful scores with Colt Revolvers and Automatic Pistols, as the careful craftsmanship employed in their manufacture insures the absolute accuracy of each Colt. From 6 to 20 rounds, including all the different kinds of ammunition adapted for use in the Arm are shot from each Colt Revolver and



Automatic Pistol and the targets thus made,

initialed by the marksman, accompany the Arm to its final inspection. This includes tests and final adjustments of the action, trigger pull, etc., and it is only after this final inspection that the Arm is stamped with the triangular Colt Proof Mark, which you will see on each Colt Fire Arm.

Among the points where absolute accuracy must be maintained to insure the quality demanded in the manufacture of Colt Arms are:



Alignment of cylinder chambers with barrel. Head space and barrel clearance on cylinder. Alignment of front sight with relation to frame.

The average number of operations on each Colt Revolver is 874, and on each Colt Automatic Pistol is 915.

The above description of Colt Fire Arms manufacture is certain to create a vivid impression of the thoroughness which characterizes every act performed in the Colt factory. It is only through this unflagging attention to even the minutest details that Colt's has attained and retained its leadership in the Fire Arms industry since 1836.

The Colt Positive Safety Lock

The expression "You can't forget to make a Colt Safe" has often been heard, due to the fact that all modern Colt Double Action Revolvers are equipped with the Colt Positive Safety Lock—which makes accidental discharge absolutely impossible. The illustration above shows the solid bar of steel, 1/10 of an inch thick, which automatically places itself between the hammer and the cartridge head—remainand the cartridge head - remaining in this position at all times except when the trigger is intentionally pulled.

Colt One-Piece Revolver Frame



The Colt One-Piece Frame is forged from one solid piece of steel into the forward end of which the barrel is permanently fastened by means of a tapered thread. There are no joints or hinges to impair its strength or disturb the permanent alignment of cylinder chambers with barrel. This construction insures absolute rigidity and unusual durability.

All Colt Revolver cylinders turn right. This feature alone marks the Colt as the greatest achievement in revolver manufacture. Years ago Colt's discarded the left turning cylinder as impractical, because of liability to force the cylinder chamber out of line with the barrel causing a certain amount of the bullet to be sheared off by the barrel. No Arm can possibly be accurate unless the chamber and barrel are in perfect line. Right turning holds the crane tightly against the frame — the cylinder chamber and barrel always in absolute line for every shot.

THE COLT POSITIVE LOCK

The Colt Positive Lock operates automatically between the frame and the

face of the hammer in all modern Colt double-action revolvers. It requires no manipulation by the operator, hence the expression: "You can't forget to make a Colt Safe." When the trigger is drawn back as the hammer is cocked or drawn to a rearward position the positive lock or safety is drawn downward permitting the full blow of the hammer to fall directly upon the primer of the cartridge if the trigger is held in this position. At all




other times the Positive Lock prevents the hammer nose from coming into contact with the primer.

You have 1/10 inch of steel between the hammer and the frame. To explode a cartridge in a Colt Revolver with the Positive Lock in safe position it would be necessary to drive 1/10 inch of solid steel into the frame before the hammer nose could reach the primer to expolde it. Even should the revolver be dropped, the hammer become caught in the clothing, or struck a blow in any manner, or if, in drawing the hammer back it should slip from under the thumb (with your finger out of the trigger guard) the hammer of all modern Colt Revolvers cannot in any way come in contact with the primer, therefore accidental discharge is impossible.

CALIBER:

Colt Rearward Action Safety Type Cylinder Latch.

The Cylinder Latch used on all Double Action Colt Revolvers is unique for two important reasons: (1) the rigidity with which it holds the cylinder tightly in place, (2) the fact that it must be deliberately forced backward before the callinder can be thrown out cylinder can be thrown out. The latter is especially important in police Arms where the Arm is often jerked hurriedly from the holster or pocket and instantly fired. The Colt Latch is so designed that pressing the thumb designed that pressing the thumb forward cannot possibly acci-dentally release the latch, as is frequently the case with forward action latches. This safety feature in itself makes the Colt Revolver outstanding.

Here is a "snub-nosed" Colt, shooting the powerful .38 Special cartridge, yet small enough to ride handily in the side pocket of coat or overcoat. While primarily a "close quarters" quick action Revolver this short-barreled Colt has proved itself unusually accurate for an Arm of this type. The Detective Special Revolver is identical in construction and quality with the Colt Police Positive Special except for the barrel length. It has the same safety feature — the COLT POSITIVE LOCK, preventing unintentional discharge.

This special model Colt is particularly adapted for the "plain-clothes man" on special duty who must be prepared for a surprise attack

with no time to draw a regulation arm from holster or hip pocket. The plain-clothes men of the Detroit Police Department are equipped with

this Arm. The outstanding feature of this Colt Model is, of course, its compact size. Its length and shape permit it to be carried conveniently

in the pocket. There is no more rugged firearm in its size and weight than the Detective Special and none of more businesslike appearance.

Colt Improved Grip

Skill in shooting does not require any unusual ability. Persistent, well directed practice will enable anyone to shoot well. And in no other way can this skill be acquired than by practice. Colt's has always exercised special care in the manufacture, adjustment and targeting of its target models, and each is accompanied by a test target signed by the expert making the gallery test.

It is a waste of good ammunition for anyone to start shooting until they have learned how to stand, how to grasp the Arm, how to aim and how and when to pull the trigger. Each of these steps requires practice and until some knowledge is gained in all these directions it is a good plan to use an unloaded Arm. The very first thing for the novice to learn is how to grasp and hold a Fire Arm.



The stock of the Colt Revolver or Pistol is made to fit the hand naturally, easily and snugly. Grasp the Arm as shown in illustration at the left, and note how cosily it fits the hand — how firm and ample it feels and how sure an aim may be taken. This Colt Grip is scientifically designed to comfortably fit any hand

regardless of size, and absorb the recoil without derangement of the aim. The picture shows the proper grip or hold. The revolver should be grasped with the thumb and last three fingers; the index finger is held outside the trigger guard until ready to fire.

The grasp should not be so tight as to cause tremors of the hand or arm to be communicated to the Revolver, but should be firm enough to avoid losing the grip when the recoil takes place. Owing to the fact that the recoil is ex-

erted in a line above the hand which grasps the stock and takes up the recoil, an upward motion is imparted to the muzzle at discharge.

If the hand is so placed that the grip is largely on one side of the stock the rotary motion is upward and to the opposite side. Therefore, the grasp




should be such that the hand which sustains the recoil should be high on the butt and directly behind it.

To avoid any possibility of the fingers slipping from the trigger when pressure is exerted the triggers of all Colt Revolvers and Automatic Pistols, except four models are checked. The trigger of the "Woodsman" model is deeply grooved. Also to aid in overcoming the recoil many of the Colt target models have checked back strap, and any Colt Arm may be had with this special work at small extra cost.

The accuracy of any revolver is determined to a large extent by the method used in lining up the chambers of the cylinder with the barrel. All Colt Cylinders turn to the right—thus binding the crane light against the frame of the revolver—absolutely guaranteeing perfect alignment of chamber and barrel and adding materially to the accuracy of the arm. An additional feature which makes for greater accuracy is found in the small amount of clearance between the barrel end and the front of the cylinder—bearly large enough to allow light to pass through.

The Police Positive Revolver is a medium powered Arm of light weight and small size. It is easy to handle and fits the pocket without undue drag on the clothing or bulge in the pocket. For these reasons, it is chosen by those who desire a light, strong Arm of ample power which is, at the same time, accurate and safe. The option of calibers and barrel lengths, places the Police Positive in the front rank of Fire Arm versatility. It may be shot either single or double action and, as in all other Colt double action Revolvers, the COLT POSITIVE LOCK protects against accidental discharge.

Special Features

Due to its reliability, durability, accuracy and safety the Police Positive Revolver is a favorite among Police Departments, Bank Guards, Special Police and Detectives. The Householder, Storekeeper, Motorist and Traveler also find the Police Positive Revolver particularly well suited to their

needs. Special features combined in the Police



Positive Revolver are the superb balance, so necessary to accurate shooting, the full COLT GRIP, and the safety with which it may be handled. The Colt Positive lock operates automatically, making accidental discharge impossible.


Correct Firing Position

Shooters differ somewhat in their manner of standing, but in many respects there is a similarity in the "stance" of all good shooters. You should stand in a natural easy manner with right foot advanced (for right hand shooting) and your weight evenly distributed. Your body will face slightly to the left

of the target, your right arm fully extended in a direct line toward the target. This position is, of course, reversed for left hand shooting. Do not tense the muscles nor swing the body so far to the left as to strain the neck muscles in sight-

The position of the free arm, while not of vital importance, should not be such as to disturb the aim, as might be the case if allowed to swing at the side. Some shooters put the free arm behind their backs, others place the hand in the coat or trousers pocket or rest it on the hip. The shooter himself is the only person who can determine the easiest and most natural pose. A little experimenting on his part will quickly settle the point in his mind. The best position for the feet is also a matter for

much the same as that shown in the illustration.

Many people think that the expert shot holds his Pistol out with a steady hand, gets it right over the bull's-eye and pulls the trigger. He doesn't. There's no such thing as holding a pistol dead on a bull's-eye and shooting. The Arm is bound to sway to and fro, if ever so slightly. The only way to hit the center of a bull's-eye is to have the hammer fall just when the sight crosses the aiming point. The shooter cocks the hammer with his thumb, extends his arm, raising the Pistol to the line of sight, being sure that the piece is not canted to left or right but held perfectly level: then taking a long breath, takes aim at the lower edge of the bull's-eye, which is known as the "six o'clock hold" and begins gradually to press the trigger. It will be found that the Arm will weave back and forth and around the aiming point. The best shot in the world could not hit a bull's-eye if he had not developed a good "trigger squeeze." Be careful to squeeze the trigger slowly; do not jerk or twist it or you will get a wild shot. If you find that your shots are inclined to go to the left (with a right-handed shooter) or to the right (with a lefthanded shooter) increase the thumb pressure on the side of the Revolver.

As you look over your Revolver to sight it, the front sight should just fill the rear notch, the top of the front sight should be even with the top of the rear sight with an even distribution of light on each side, and both sights in line with the spot on the target just below the point you wish to hit. Colt Revolvers are sighted at 15 yards to place the shots 3/4 inch above the point of aim. At 10 to 12 feet hold ON the object you want to hit. There is a false belief that the shooter must guess how much to allow for the flip of his Pistol. It is true there is a recoil, but the shooter doesn't have to do any guessing. When Colt Arms are tested the sights are adjusted and allowance is made for the upward flip due to the recoil. If the Arm is properly grasped and the sighting is correct the shot will be accurately placed.

The standard front sights furnished with Colt Revolvers and Automatic Pistols designed for regular Police, Military, home and other protective service as well as for the hunter, tourist and general outdoor use are of the "fixed" variety, that is, they are not adjustable. The front sight is so constructed that the Arm may be easily drawn from the pocket or holster. 



Colt Automatic Pistols

Although the Colt is the best known of all Automatic Pistols, there are some people who consider this Arm complicated compared with the more familiar Colt Revolver. As a matter of fact, there are fewer parts in a caliber .32 Colt Automatic Pistol than in the Police Positive Special Revolver. The action of a Colt Automatic Pistol differs, however, from the Colt Revolver action.

COLT AUTOMATIC GRIP SAFETY

As to the Colt Automatic Grip Safety the results achieved are the same as with



the Colt Positive Lock. The accompanying diagram shows this device as incorporated in calibers .32 and .380 Colt Automatic Pistols. A similar safety is also applied to the caliber .25 Pocket Model, Super .38, Government Model .45 and Ace Automatic Pistols. The front arm of the U-shaped sear engages the hammer notch; the lower point rests against end of trigger, and the short rear arm of the sear lies directly under the hooked end of

the grip safety. Pulling the trigger will move the arm of the pivoted sear in two directions — the long arm moves to the front and out of the notch of the hammer, releasing the same, and the short arm moves upward. BUT, as the hook end of the grip safety lies directly above the short arm of the sear, it is seen that the sear is securely blocked until the grip safety is pressed inward (to the front as indicated by the arrow), then the hooked end clears the short arm of the sear and permits it to move upward into the hollow in rear of the hook. It will thus be plainly seen how the Colt Automatic Grip Safety positively prevents accidental discharge in all modern Colt Automatic Pistols equipped with this safety feature.

Besides the Automatic Grip Safety, which does not permit the hammer to be released unless the pistol is taken into the hand in position to be fired, all modern Colt Automatic Pistols are provided with a manual Safety Lock. When the hammer is cocked, the Safety Lock may be pushed upward so that it will engage with a corresponding cut in the slide, locking it and at the same time blocking all operating connections between the trigger and hammer, so that the hammer can by no means be lowered while the Safety Lock is engaged with the slide. The Safety Lock can be pressed down by the thumb of the right hand when ready to shoot, entailing no loss of time.

In addition to the two safeties mentioned above all modern Colt Automatic Pistols in calibers .25, .32 and .380 have what is known as the Safety Disconnector which positively breaks all connection between trigger and sear when magazine is withdrawn. This prevents accidental discharge even if the Arm is cocked and a cartridge remains in the chamber.





REPAIRS

Complete facilities are maintained at the Colt plant for the repairing of all modern Colt Revolvers and Automatic Pistols. Genuine Colt parts are fitted and adjusted by expert repairmen and your Arm is thoroughly checked before it is returned to you. Thousands of parts are kept in stock, making it possible to effect necessary repairs in the least possible time. An estimate of repair costs will be sent for your approval before proceeding with the work, unless otherwise specified by you.

All Arms and parts sent to us must be plainly marked with the sender's

name and address, with express charges fully prepaid.

A copy of the complete Colt catalog of Replacement Parts will be gladly mailed on request. Replacement parts may be purchased direct from the factory, where the shooter wishes to insert new parts himself. If parts orders are accompanied by remittance, prompt shipments can be made. However, we recommend wherever possible the Arm be returned to the factory for complete inspection and fitting of parts.

AMMUNITION

Extreme care should be taken to see that none but cartridges recommended for the respective Arms are used. Factory loaded ammunition should be used exclusively, as with home loading, errors are bound to occur. Therefore, we will not be responsible for trouble arising from the use of ammunition other than that loaded by responsible cartridge manufacturers (and guaranteed by them). Calibers .32-20, .38-40 and .44-40 "High Velocity" or "High Speed" rifle cartridges as manufactured for use in *Rifles* are not intended for Revolvers. A complete diagram of cartridges to be used in the various Colt Arms will be found on the preceding page.

ORDERING

In making out orders care should be taken to give explicit shipping directions and full name and address. Also state clearly the name of the model and the caliber of the Arm desired and the length of the barrel and the finish wanted — whether blued or nickel. Blued finish is always sent unless otherwise specified. Pearl or Ivory Stocks can be fitted or supplied when desired at reasonable extra cost for any Colt Fire Arm (except the .22 Automatic Pistol). No arms are shipped by us on approval. Deliveries will be made through dealers only.
